## Raising Chickens:

Children at Risk provided training for 4 families in the province of Takoe on raising chickens as a business. During the training they were also joined by pastor Lo. Once the families have chickens, they will raise them and sell them for a profit. This will provide them with the income they need to support themselves. Children at Risk built a chicken coop for Nakhim's family and it has been very successful. They have taken their business further and bought more chickens from the village to sell at the market. In establishing this business, the family now has an income of \$10-15 a day.



## Training with Cecil:

Training on Micro Enterprise and Agriculture was held at the church in Kandal province for the families of seven sponsored children. During the training session, Cecil taught them about the importance of making good use of their land and in establishing their own business so that they can improve their standard of living. It was well received as many families saw how it benefited them and expressed a desire to study with him again.

- All the businesses the families are setting up become self-sufficient
- That the families keep close to God and learn to depend on him
- The children studying that they embrace their education
- For the teams coming to help train the families in the provinces
- For the children leaving school, that they would have a better life and continue to follow Jesus

## Sticky Rice Cakes & Sugarcane Juice:

Chan Thorn's grandma started a business making sticky rice cakes and soup in order to provide for Chan Thom's education and to support the family. She earns \$10-15 a day which is only enough for food. Children at Risk has provided her with a sugarcane machine which has helped her expand her business.
