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I. Summary

In Scripture, we have countless examples of people coming to faith because of the healing of their bodies. The same is true today. When someone cares for someone's body, it opens a door to touch their soul for the kingdom of God. The ultimate goal of the Patient Care / Healing Home Ministry is to help build up New Life Fellowship churches by showing the love of Jesus to the sick people in the communities where New Life Fellowship has a presence.

We do this by helping connect the sick to where they can get the medical help they need. We help cover costs and even give them a place to stay with free room and board and lots of prayer when they come to Phnom Penh for medical help. We reach out to the sick and poor through organized medical outreaches and referrals from Healthcare assistants we train up in several NLF church locations. This gives us more of an opportunity to share the gospel with people that may have never heard the gospel. The mission of the **Healing Home** is to be a respected place known for where people see miracles happen. A place known for helping and ministering to people and impacting them so when they return home again, they testify how great God is and how God used the Healing Home to restore their health. Our hope and vision are to see more church plants started because of the introduction to the gospel that the **Patient Care Ministry (PCM)** and **Healing Home** has made to patients and their families that they have helped. Our aim is to establish a relationship between the church, people in the community and the medical services available so that together we can bring a holistic approach to our ministry which includes physical, spiritual and emotional healing.

For year 2019 our plan is to partner with church planters and when we have patients that are referred to the Healing Home that get saved but do not have a home church, we will give their names and address given to the church planter team in hopes that this will open a door for a church to be established in their community.

Patient Care Ministry (PCM) provides four main projects

- Healing Home
- Short-Term Village Mobile Medical Clinics
- Health Education Project
- Referral Center in Phnom Penh

II. Introduction

New Life Fellowship was founded in 1994 as a response to the urgent need to rebuild the war-torn nation of Cambodia and to equip Cambodians to have a hope-filled future.

New Life Fellowship exists to plant a large New Testament Church in Phnom Penh which will have a positive influence on every sector of Cambodian society: Religion, Education, Politics, Social Relationships, Business, Sports and Communications - and will be a model and resource center for planting churches in every province of Cambodia with the same philosophy and foundation and to send Cambodians as missionaries to other countries.

Since 1994, New Life has had a track record of being a catalyst for genuine life transformation, as well as good stewardship of God-given opportunities and resources. New Life has intentionally been maintaining its focus on what will have the utmost eternal impact as well as being a generous resource center and model for the larger Body of Christ in Cambodia.

New Life Fellowship community outreach arm, New Life Foundation, partners with Cambodia's Ministries of Education, Youth, and Sports through several projects including our Skills Training Centers, Children at Risk child sponsorship program, Patient Care Ministry as well as other initiatives. Over 20,000 people have been ministered to through New Life Fellowship's various initiatives since its inception in 1994.

New Life Fellowship has been recognized not only by the Cambodian government, but also by both Christian and secular groups in Cambodia and abroad as having a profound grassroots impact on Cambodian society.

The vision and opportunities provided by New Life Fellowship continue to be of utmost relevance to the needs of the Cambodian people.

III. Need

- 1. Healing Home (HH):** The HH is a short-term residential facility located in Phnom Penh. The purpose of the HH is provide temporary housing to those from the village who are seeking medical care in the city and cannot afford to pay for personal lodging. The HH offers basic rooms and meals. Our staff also provide emotional and spiritual support by sharing Christ's love, encouragement, and words of healing prayers.
- 2. Mobile Medical Clinics:** PCM hosts medical teams from all over the world including the Australia, Canada, England, and the USA regularly. In partnership with New Life's network of churches across Cambodia, PCM is able to provide short medical clinics including physician assessment, dental check-ups, pharmaceutical prescriptions, and follow-up care to the HH if needed.
- 3. Health Education Project:** When there are Health Trainers available, we have them educate staff and medical people. We also provide health education and conduct medical outreaches where there is health care needs especially in rural areas.
- 4. Referral Center:** PCM is a catalyst for connecting those in the villages who have healthcare needs that cannot be met by the village Healthcare Centers to clinics and hospitals in Phnom Penh. PCM helps to provide transportation, lodging at the HH if needed, financial support, and medical referrals to partner clinics and hospitals. PCM works directly in partnership with the local church to provide this service.

IV. Objectives

The vision of PCM is motivated by a sense of urgency for the sick and a determination to bring hope to the suffering. The goal of PCM is to show God's love and compassion for the sick in a personal and tangible way by providing healthcare services.

The goals of the projects are to:

- ✓ Help people of all ages to be healthy in body, soul, and spirit
- ✓ Bring comfort to the sick
- ✓ Help people regain physical wellness
- ✓ Equip and empower Village Healthcare Assistants

It is essential that we monitor on a regular basis the progress and implementation of the program. This will consist of regular updates (via phone calls and occasional visits) from the PCM staff. Each person who receives services from PCM receives a medical record number, and is tracked. Healthcare intervention outcomes are recorded and evaluated for each individual by the PCM staff.
